Rio Bank would like to congratulate Cecilia Guillot, First Vice President Deposit Quality Manager, who was recently selected to participate in the Coast Guard commissioning of the 48th Sentinel-class fast response cutter Pablo Valent as it was placed into service at Coast Guard Sector Saint Petersburg, Florida on May 11, 2022. Cecilia Guillot, Pablo Valent's great niece, is the ship's sponsor.

The cutter's namesake, Pablo Valent, originally from Corpus Christi, Texas, joined the United States Life-Saving Service in 1912 and spent the bulk of his service at the Coast Guard station in Brazos, Texas. In September 1919, Valent guided a 36-foot motor surf boat into some of the worst sea conditions ever seen in the Gulf Coast area & helped rescue the eight crew members of the hurricane-damaged 77-ton schooner Cape Horn off the coast of Corpus Christi, Texas. For his heroic efforts, Valent received the Silver Lifesaving Medal and the Grand Cross of the American Cross of Honor Society. Chief Boatswain's Mate Pablo Valent continued an extremely successful career in the U.S. Coast Guard. In 1935, he assumed command of Coast Guard Station on South Padre Island, Texas, becoming the first Hispanic-American in charge of a search and rescue station. In 1940, Pablo Valent retired after 28 years of honorable service to his nation. Valent Hall, a facility at Coast Guard Sector Corpus Christi, is also named after Pablo Valent.


